Art Grant Deadlines are March 1st & April 1st, 2019 Grant funds are available for East Central Regional Arts Council programs.

Funding is awarded to individuals and organizations in our region – Chisago, Isanti, Kanabec, Mille Lacs and Pine counties in east central Minnesota – for performing, visual, media, creative writing and other arts projects.



- Scholarships for K-12 kids are up to \$500 for a special art project. This application process is open now & are due March 1.
- Essential Artist Awards are \$7,000 each for professional artists. This application process is open now and are due March 1.
- Other grants to artists are from \$1,000 up to \$2,500. These applications will be open soon and are due April 1.
- Project grants for arts & other organizations range from \$500 to \$15,000.
 Applications will be open soon & are due April 1.
